

Out of State Grants

The Division of Physical Therapy offers a select number of grants designed to enable a small number of highly qualified non-resident matriculants to receive financial assistance which lessens the disparity between resident and non-resident tuition. This program is similar to one used in the Graduate School as a way to broaden the reach of the academic program. Please contact [Peter Berres](#) for more information regarding these grants.

Out of State Resident Scholarship Criteria

In order to have the opportunity to benefit from the Doctor of Physical therapy Non-resident Student Scholarship, the following criteria must be met:

1. Overall GPA must be 3.25 or above
2. Key GPA must be 3.5 or above
3. GRE (combined verbal and quantitative scores) is expected to be 1000 or above

The PT admissions committee along with the Office of Student Affairs will review the incoming students' pre-PT grades to determine if they qualify.

To continue receiving this scholarship, students must maintain a DPT program GPA of 3.0 or above.
