Nomination Form

The University of Kentucky Public Health Hall of Fame was established in 2004 by the UK College of Public Health to honor individuals who have, over their lifetime, made significant contributions to the field of public health and the health and welfare of the citizens of the commonwealth, the nation and the world.

Who is eligible?

- A Kentuckian who has made major contributions to the health of populations, through process or outcome public health activities, in Kentucky, the nation, or internationally.
- A non-Kentuckian who has made similar contributions to public health in Kentucky.
- Nominations can be made for both living and posthumous candidates.

What is the criterion for selection to the Hall of Fame is?

The impact the individual's efforts and work have made on public health. Specifically, the impact on the overall infrastructure, health outcomes and health status of Kentuckians, the nation and the world will be considered.

- Hall of Fame ceremony is held each **October** during Homecoming Week.
- Nominations may be submitted, and will be accepted only, from **March 15 to May 31** each year.
- The Selection Committee will review nominations **between June 1 and June 30.**
- Inductees will be announced no later than **July 1**
