

**Option 1: Graduate Certificate in Maternal and Child Health (MCH), 15 hours (Awaiting Approval)**

*Health Behavior requirements plus an additional 3 hours (CPH 740) can complete the coursework for the MCH Certificate.*

- A. Required:**
- CPH 646/740, Introduction to Maternal and Child Health
  - CPH 605, Epidemiology (required for Health Behavior)
- B. Nine hours (9) of selectives which may include courses marked with (\*) above. See the MCH Director for more information and listings of approved selective courses.**

**Option 2: Graduate Certificate in Global Health (GH), 15 hours (Awaiting Approval)**

*Health Behavior requirements plus an additional 9 hours can complete the coursework for the GH Certificate.*

- A. Required:**
- CPH 751, Introduction to Global Health
  - CPH 605, Epidemiology (required for Health Behavior)
  - CPH 709, Global Health Internship
- B. Six hours (6) of selectives which may include courses on marked with (\*\*\*) above. Three of these hours must be taken outside the College of Public Health. Some of the hours for CPH 709 may count towards Practicum hours (CPH 609). See the GH Director for more information and listings of approved selective courses.**

**Option 3: Graduate Certificate in Gerontology, 15 hours**

*Health Behavior requirements plus an additional 12 hours can complete the coursework for the Gerontology Certificate.*

- A. Students take a 3 hour course from each of the following areas:**
- Biomedical Sciences and Health Services
  - Social and Behavioral Sciences Policy
  - Planning and Ethics
- B. An additional 3 hour course is taken from any of the three areas above.**
- C. Students complete a 210 hour Practicum in aging. This requirement can be met by CPH 609 focusing on aging or taken in addition to CPH 609.**

**Option 4: Dual Concentrations**

**Students take a minimum of an additional 12 hours (15 hours are common) chosen in discussion with the chair of the other concentration's department.**
