Researchers at the University of Kentucky Department of Ophthalmology are conducting a research study on macular edema due to retinal vein occlusion. They are testing the safety and effectiveness of a small drug delivery system that, when injected into the eye, releases a steroid slowly over a period of time.

You may be eligible for this study if you:

- are 18 years of age and older; and
- have a diagnosis of macular edema due to retinal vein occlusion; and
- have been diagnosed with macular edema due to retinal vein occlusion within the past 12 months.
