



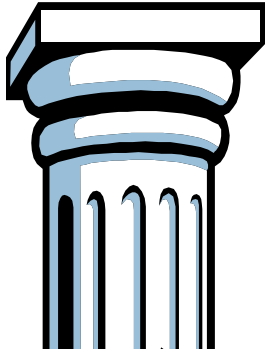

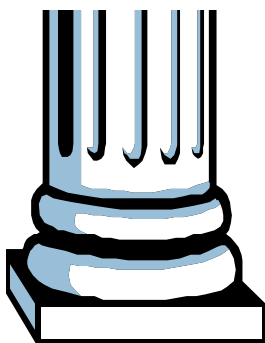

Jack and fellow Veterans will present on their experiences during WWII. Guests from the Veterans Museum will join us as well. Jack Ellis will also share the experiences of the Veterans he interviewed in his book Patriots and Heroes. Exhibits will be set up including photos, memorabilia and uniforms. This event is a collaborative effort between the OLLI at UK in Morehead, Rowan County Veterans Foundation, Morehead United Methodist Church, and Corbie Ellington American Legion Post 126.

## Political Economy: Election Year Topics

**Course fee:** \$10

These seminars are designed for participants with little or no formal training in economics. Rather they are aimed at stimulating thought and interactive discussion on how economic ideas and ideology can be utilized to shed light on the consequences of specific policies proposed by those who wish to be elected to congressional and/or executive office. The individual sessions will begin with a short outline of the philosophical foundations of modern economic thought and then proceed to specific topics directly related to current political issues. These include, but need not be limited to: taxation; public spending; interest rates; inflation; jobs; medical care; social security; public and private debt; interest rates; the housing market; income distribution; military spending; and foreign aid.

## Genealogy 102

**Course fee:** no additional class fee

Back by popular demand will be a course in genealogical research in which participants will delve into their family roots. On the first day, bring what you have: file folders, a sketch of a family tree, or only the names and dates for your family a generation or two ago. Cindy and Georgi will explain the resources available for you to build on, especially through the RCPL. Thereafter, each session will consist of an hour during which more experienced genealogists will explain an aspect of this type of research including: accessing the Federal Census in your genealogical research, DNA testing and what it means, genealogy conferences, and resources such as immigration records, passenger lists, deeds, photos, newspaper items, museums, letters, diaries, marriage records and internet sites. Then, the second hour will be "hands-on", using RCPL computers, your laptop or tablet. At the end of the course, class members will give a brief progress report to the others. There will also be a field trip to Rowan County Court House to learn to use Court Records.

## Studio Art: Drawing

### Session 1: *Drawing with Anything, with Sandy*

This class will explore drawing one subject with a variety of drawing tools which give unexpected and uncommon results. The drawing itself and quality of line will become more important than the subject. It is hoped that the participants will share ideas and participate in friendly discussions.

### Session 2: *Drawing with Feeling, with Sandy*

Artists share emotions with others by communicating through color, shapes, and lines. Everyone has the ability to read emotions in others. This class will take a look at works of art for the emotional content. Students will then deliberately set about creating art to convey a certain "mood," such as peacefulness, joy, anxiety or excitement. It is hoped that the end result will be at least one finished drawing plus a heightened sense of awareness and a new approach to looking at future works of art.

### Sessions 3 & 4: *Expressive Drawing Techniques with Joe*

Joe will teach the 3rd and 4th classes building on continuity of expressive drawing techniques, emphasizing eye/hand coordination.

## Technology Topics Tailored To You

The five sessions in this course will include: Technological Gadgets, such as iPod, iPad, iPhone, eBooks, such as Nook and Kindle readers; digital cameras and using the pictures we take for different purposes; becoming knowledgeable about buying and selling on eBay and Craigslist and avoiding pitfalls of both; and using email services and how to attach documents and resize pictures to messages. A fifth session will be used to address the needs and interests of the group. The facilitator will be Carol Laferty, with other presenters invited to address the specifics of topics planned, including Georgi Ramey, Richard Spivey and John Maxey. This class is co-sponsored by the Maysville Community and Technical College, Rowan Campus.

Predicting the FUTURE has always been more of an art than a science, but in the creation of *films* those two disciplines merge to inspire thoughtful analysis. Even if you did not see last fall's "*The Science in Science Fiction Movies*" one should enjoy this new series of thought provoking movies. Discussions will again follow each *film* with a focus on the historic, scientific, social, and political issues encountered. With the support of the **Rowan County Library** each *film* will be shown in the library's Community Room on **Thursdays starting at 1:00 PM** on the dates show below. This new series will begin with an early historic 1930's Sci-Fi classic *Metropolis*. Unless you are a movie history fan you will probably know little about our first film and the politics behind it.

1. *Metropolis* - This film battle was over social and political warfare in a dystopian world.
2. *The Time Machine* - A 1960s era film based on H.G. Well's novel from the 1900s.
3. *2010: The Year We Made Contact* - You don't want to miss this 1984 sequel to *2001: A Space Odyssey* (1968)
4. *Close Encounters of the Third Kind* - How would we communicate with extra-terrestrials???
5. *Independence Day* - Pure entertainment in an encounter with an aggressive civilization from another world.

Join us as we get together to discuss a variety of non-fiction books. At the first meeting, SIG members will brainstorm and choose which books will be discussed in the coming months. The SIG typically gathers at 2:00pm on the 2nd Monday of each month at Coffee Tree Book Store. First meeting is on March 12th.
- 4. SPANISH - BEGINNING & INTERMEDIATE** **Facilitator: Sarah Cano**  
This SIG, held 1:30 - 3:00pm on Tuesday afternoons starting March 6th at RCPL in the small conference room, is for people who have a beginning knowledge and want to practice Spanish. It is appropriate for intermediate level students and as a refresher course as well. Students work in pairs, or groups, in an informal, relaxed setting, help each other and can work at their own pace. Hispanic culture is also included. Students share interests in music, food, customs, etc. The textbook is *Spanish for Communication* by Jarvis/Levredo, 4th ed. (D.C. Heath and Co., 1992), and can be bought used on-line.
