In order to ensure that everyone has a safe and enjoyable time, we have some guidelines that we expect you to follow. Please read them carefully.



TRY- IT Participant General Expectations

1. Proper attire is expected every day of camp. You may NOT wear short shorts, mini-skirts, revealing tops, visible undergarments, sagging pants, etc. If you get into the van wearing inappropriate clothing you will be sent home for the day. Ball caps must be worn straightforward or straight back only.
2. Absolutely no open toe shoes are allowed. No flip-flops. All shoes must be properly fastened.
3. Ipods, mp3 players, CD players, etc. must be left at home. Any use of telephones will be on an emergency basis only. Please see a counselor or staff member to make emergency calls. (Emergency calls do not include social calls to friends... only to a parent or guardian).
4. Students are not allowed to leave the classroom without counselor supervision. This includes meals, classes, and recreation.
5. Displays of improper conduct, such as disrespect of staff, UK property or other students, will not be tolerated. We work with many professionals who donate time and energy to our program free of charge. Improper conduct by anyone could jeopardize our program and end your participation in TRY-IT.
6. No cameras should be used during class time.
7. Students are to be on their best behavior at all times. We expect you to behave during TRY-IT class time as you would during classes at your school. Disciplinary problems, such as speaking out of turn, will not be tolerated. No PDA (public displays of affection).
8. This summer program is devoted to you. Every attempt will be made to make this a very rewarding and informative experience. Please understand that the rules are set for your protection and must be followed. Anyone who violates the stated rules will be subject to dismissal from the program - permanently.



The University of Kentucky main campus is graciously providing use of the facilities for TRY-IT participants. In return all participants must abide by UK campus guidelines.

Below is a brief list of those guidelines:

1. The University of Kentucky and the TRY-IT! Program staff reserve the right to add to or delete from these policies any clause upon timely notification.
2. Neither the University of Kentucky nor the TRY-IT! staff will be responsible for the loss of or damage to any personal property of TRY-IT! participants.
3. The University of Kentucky does not permit the use of its facilities for any commercial purposes whatsoever. Solicitation and gambling are strictly prohibited.
4. Smoke alarm systems in each building are hooked into the switchboard central alarm panel, which is monitored by campus security. **USE IN CASE OF EMERGENCY ONLY.**
5. Security officers make regular checks of all University buildings and facilities and must not be hindered in these activities.
6. In case of an emergency, (e.g., fire, illness, accident, building security), telephones in each building provide a direct line to the switchboard.
7. Do not block entrance to the buildings and driveways and keep free of obstacles.
8. Use or possession of open-flame, highly flammable or combustible materials, firearms, firecrackers, and all weapons is prohibited.
9. Do not place materials where they can obstruct public areas and corridors so as to hinder leaving the room / building and maintenance.



TRY-IT participants are banned from engaging in the following activities while attending the program.

- No smoking (cigarettes, snuff, pipes, etc.)
- No drugs
- No gambling
- No malicious conduct (such as fighting)
- No alcohol
- No weapons
- No cursing or name-calling
- No pets allowed
- No bullying
- No hand-holding, kissing, hugging or other public displays of affection between campers.
