**Guidelines**

**Objective:** The Dr. David R. Wekstein Centenarian Award is an opportunity for the Center on Aging Foundation to recognize and honor those who exemplify graceful aging and serve as an inspiration to others to remain engaged in life and the pursuit of personal goals. This award is given in honor of Dr. Wekstein, former associate director of the Center on Aging, who initiated the Centenarian Program and the BRAiNS project while at the Center.

**Date:** The 2010 Dr. David R. Wekstein Centenarian Award will be announced in August, 2010.

**Event:** The Centenarian Award will be recognized at the Foundation's 24th Annual Dinner on September 7, 2010 in Lexington, Kentucky.

**Recognition:** The recipient will be featured in the event program, recognized at the dinner and receive a special award.

**Selection Committee:** Comprised of members of the Sanders-Brown Center on Aging Foundation Board.

**Nominations:** Nominations may come from individuals, organizations or other groups. These will be accepted for consideration each year and should be submitted by June 15, 2010 to the Center on Aging Foundation. Those received after the deadline will be reviewed and considered for the following year.

**Selection Criteria:** Nominees will be considered based on a variety of criteria, including:

- Age
- Current level of engagement in society
- Significant, lasting contributions in professional and/or community life
- Serving as a volunteer and/or role model for future generations
- Vision, conviction and setting high standards to inspire others

**Qualifications and restrictions:**

- Nominees shall reside in Kentucky.
- Nominees shall not be current members of the Center on Aging Foundation.

All required materials should be submitted simultaneously in one packet. These materials will not be returned. Biographical information, if available, is appreciated. A Letter of Endorsement is encouraged and up to 3 letters will be accepted and considered as part of the selection process.
