Program

- The dentist's role in oral and medical management of HIV positive/AIDS patients as part of the interdisciplinary healthcare team
- Review of infection control following OSHA and CDC guidelines to protect patients and health care workers
- Overview of moral, ethical and legal issues regarding HIV infection/AIDS
