

Directions to UK College of Dentistry

Traveling east (as from Louisville) or south on I-75 (as from Northern KY or Cincinnati):

Take I-64 east or I-75 south to exit 115. Turn right off of exit ramp onto Newtown Pike. Follow Newtown Pike to Main Street. Turn left on Main Street. Main Street will become Vine Street but you do not make any turns. Follow Vine Street through downtown. Turn right on Rose Street. Rose Street will bring you through the University of Kentucky campus. After coming through the 5th traffic light turn left onto Hospital Drive just before the Medical Center skywalk. Take an immediate right, follow past the front of University Hospital, turn left into Patient\Visitor parking.

Alternate route from east (as from Louisville, KY or Saint Louis, MO):

Take exit 65 off of I-64. Turn right at end of ramp, go about 75 yards, turn left onto 421 south (also called Leestown Pike). Follow 421 into and through downtown. 421 is Main Street in downtown which becomes Vine Street. Turn right on Rose Street (then follow same directions as above using Rose Street to come to the Medical Center).

Traveling west (as from Ashland, KY or Charleston, WV):

Follow I-64 to where it merges with I-75 north. Take exit 113. Turn right at end of ramp onto Broadway. Follow Broadway through downtown Lexington. Two blocks past Hyatt Regency hotel turn left on Maxwell Street. Go approximately 7 blocks and turn right onto Rose Street. Rose will bring you through the University of Kentucky campus. After coming through the 3rd traffic light turn left onto Hospital Drive just before the Medical Center skywalk. Take an immediate right, follow past the front of University Hospital, turn left in Patient\Visitor parking.

Traveling north (as from London, KY or Knoxville, TN):

Take I-75 north to exit 104. Turn left at end of ramp onto Athens-Boonesboro Road. Go approximately 5 miles (Athens-Boonesboro Road will become Richmond Road and then Main Street). Once you are downtown, turn left on Rose Street. You will come right through the University of Kentucky campus. After coming through the 6th traffic light, turn left onto Hospital Drive just before the Medical Center skywalk. Take an immediate right, follow past the front of University Hospital, turn left in Patient\Visitor parking.

Traveling northeast (as from Western Kentucky, Elizabethtown, KY, or Nashville, TN):

Take I-65 north. At Elizabethtown, take the bluegrass Parkway east. At end of parkway exit right onto US 60. Follow US 60 in towards Lexington. At about the sixth traffic light (counting since coming off the parkway) turn right (next to Cardinal Hill Hospital) onto Mason-Headley Road. Mason-Headley will become Waller Avenue at the intersection where St. Joseph Hospital is located, keep going straight. Turn left onto Limestone Street and make an immediate right into the drive in front of the College of Agriculture Complex. Make an immediate left. Go to end of drive. Turn left onto Hospital Drive and right into Patient\Visitor parking.

Directions from the Bluegrass Airport to UK College of Dentistry:

When leaving the airport turn left onto Man-O-War Boulevard. At the stoplight turn right onto US 60 (Versailles Rd.). Follow US 60 in towards Lexington. At about the fourth traffic light turn right (next to Cardinal Hill Hospital) onto Mason-Headley Road. Mason-Headley will become Waller Avenue at the intersection where St. Joseph Hospital is located, keep going straight. Turn left onto Limestone Street and make an immediate right into the drive in front of the College of Agriculture Complex. Make an immediate left. Go to end of drive. Turn left onto Hospital Drive and right into Patient\Visitor parking.

FOR ALL VISITORS:

Please bring your parking ticket with you so that we may validate it. Enter the University Hospital through the large revolving door.
