- In 1999, 18,874 FIVCO residents received income from social security compared to 15,930 residents in 1990. This represented a 18.5% increase.
- In 1999, 9.1% of FIVCO residents received supplemental social security income.
- 38.3% of adults (age 45+) who reside in FIVCO have an income of less than \$20,000 a year.
- 25.7% of adults (age 45+) who reside in FIVCO have an income of more than \$50,000 a year.

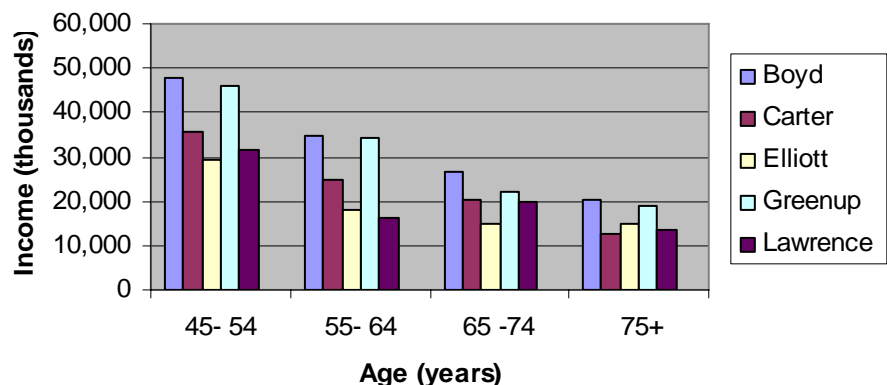

FIVCO ADD 1999 Median Annual Income**

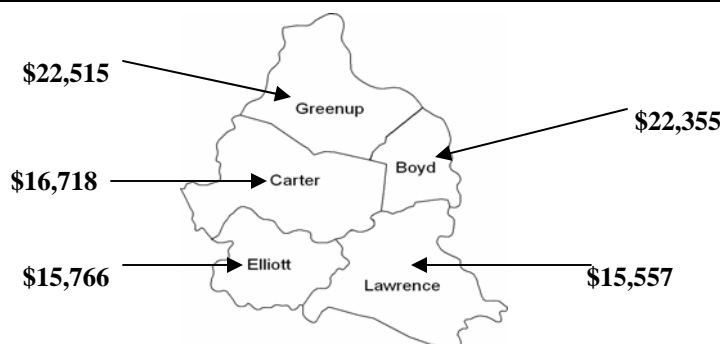
