- In 1999, 91,797 KIPDA residents received income from social security compared to 85,165 residents in 1990. This represented a 7.8% increase.
- In 1999, 4.5% of KIPDA residents received supplemental social security income.
- 24.1% of adults (age 45+) who reside in KIPDA have an income of less than \$20,000 a year.
- 40.6% of adults (age 45+) who reside in KIPDA have an income of more than \$50,000 a year.

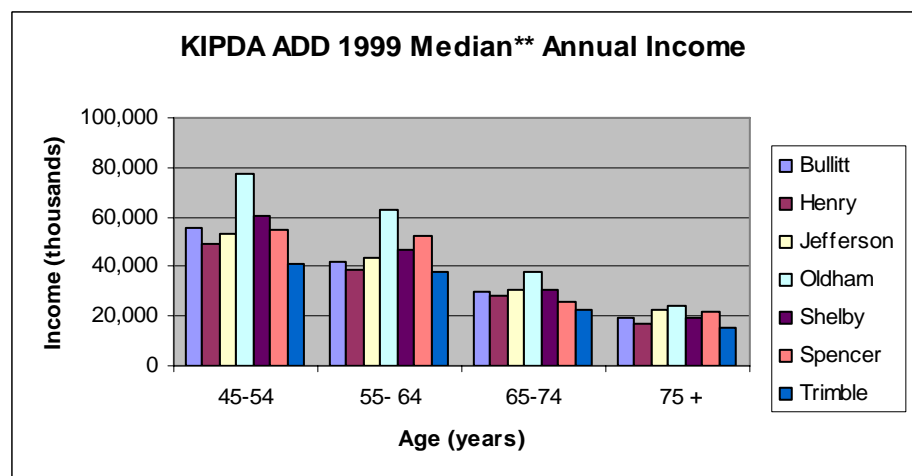

***According to the US Census Bureau: Mean income is determined by dividing the aggregate income of a certain population by the number of units in that population (US Census Bureau).

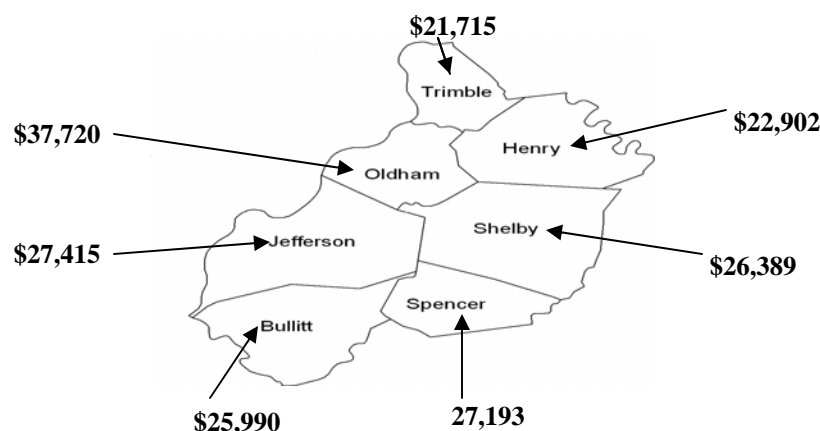

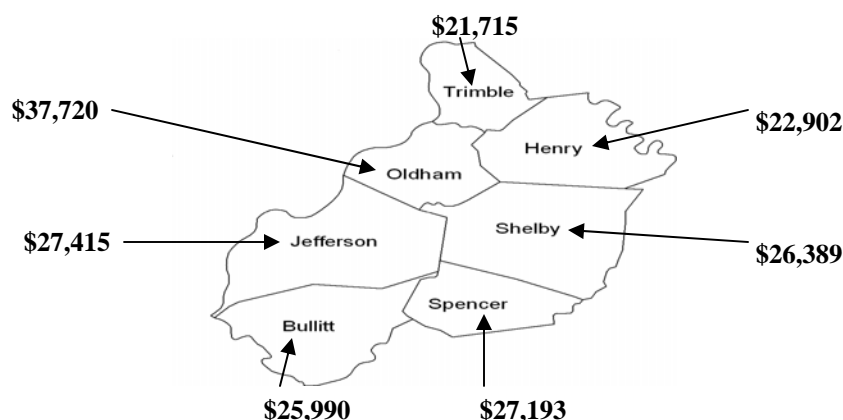
