- In 1999, 16,928 Kentucky River residents received income from social security compared to 13,344 residents in 1990. This represented a 26.9% increase.
- In 1999, 17.4% of Kentucky River residents received supplemental social security income.
- 53.4% of adults (age 45+) who reside in Kentucky River have an income of less than \$20,000 a year.
- 14.7% of adults (age 45+) who reside in Kentucky River have an income of more than \$50,000 a year.

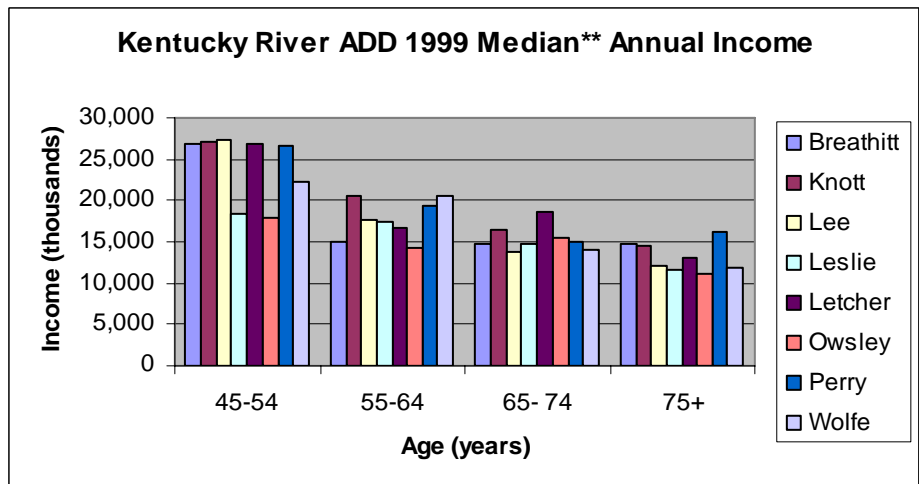

**Kentucky River ADD 1999 Median\*\* Annual Income**

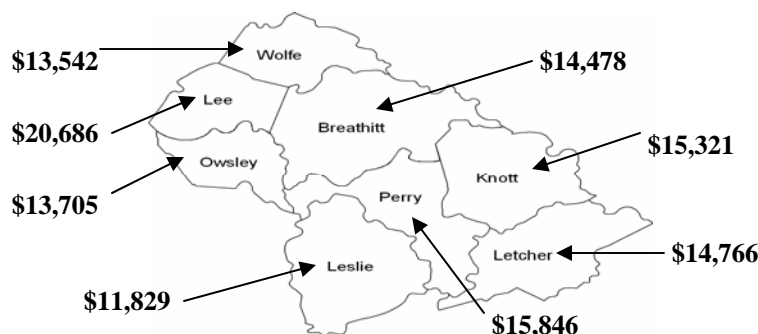

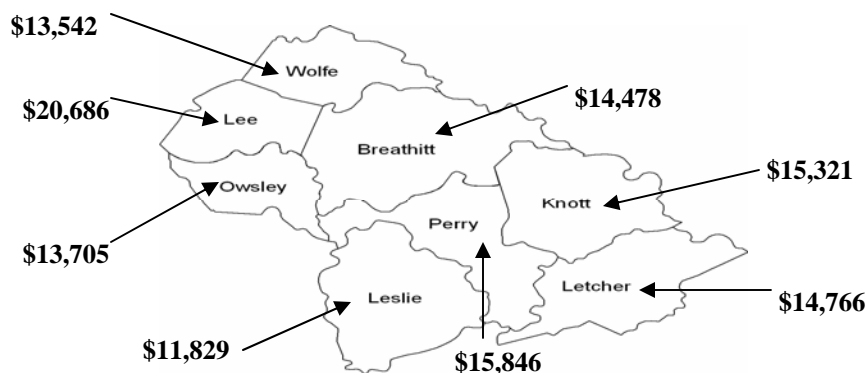
