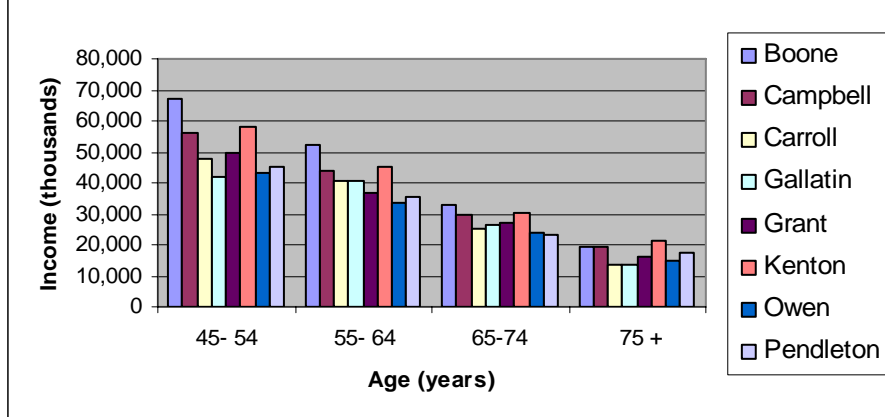
- In 1999, 36,225 Northern KY residents received income from social security compared to 33,542 in 1990. This represented a 8% increase.
- In 1999, 4.2% of Northern residents received supplemental social security income.
- 24% of adults (age 45+) who reside in Northern have an income of less than \$20,000 a year.
- 40.1% of adults (age 45+) who reside in Northern have an income greater that \$50,000 a year.

*According to the US Census Bureau: Household Income includes income of the householder and the income of any individual over the age of 15 regardless if they are related to the householder or not (US Census Bureau, 2000).

**According to the US Census Bureau: Median income is the income of any individual over the age of 15 and based on the distribution of the total number of persons (US Census Bureau, 2000).

***According to the US Census Bureau: Mean income is determined by dividing the aggregate income of a certain population by the number of units in that population (US Census Bureau).

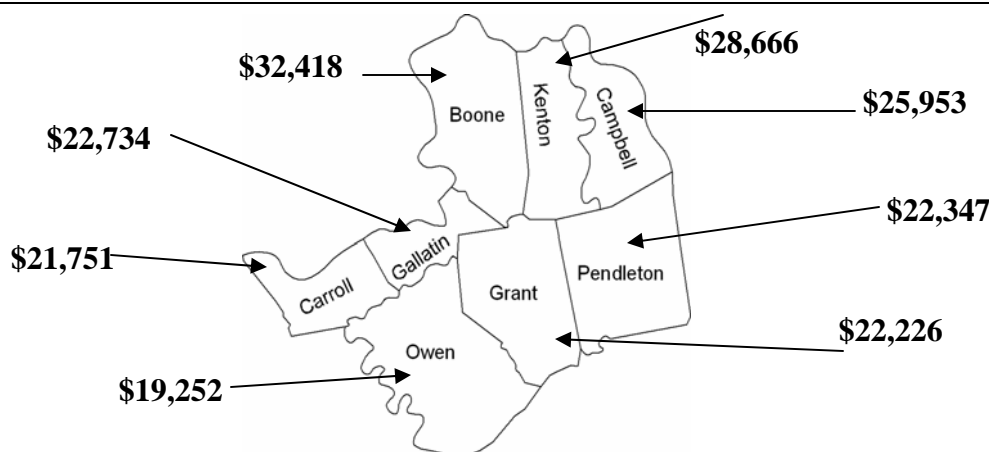
Northern ADD 1999 Median **Annual Income
