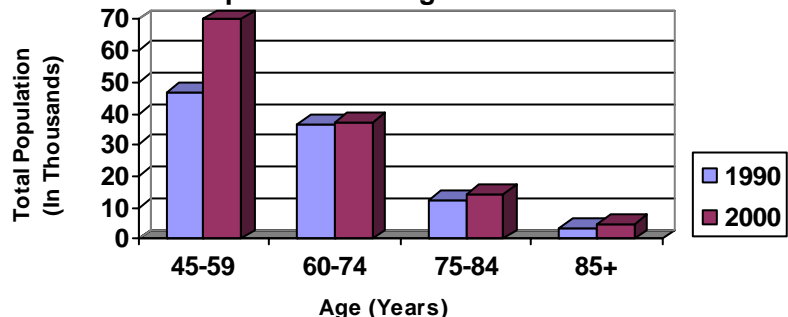

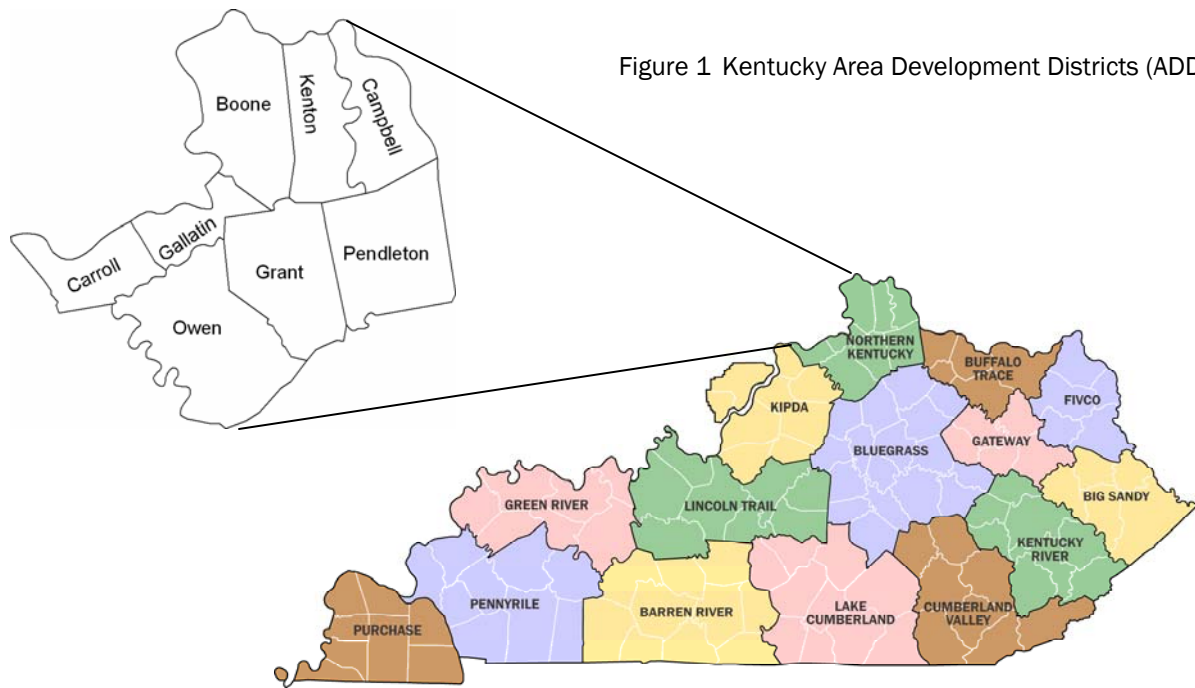


Figure 1 Kentucky Area Development Districts (ADDs)
