- In 1999, 25,349 Pennyrile residents received income from social security compared to 23,164 in 1990. This represented a 9.4% increase.
- In 1999, 6.1% of Pennyrile residents received supplemental social security income.
- 36.2% of adults (age 45+) who reside in Pennyrile have an income of less than \$20,000 a year.
- 26.2% of adults (age 45+) who reside in Pennyrile have an income greater than \$50,000 a year.

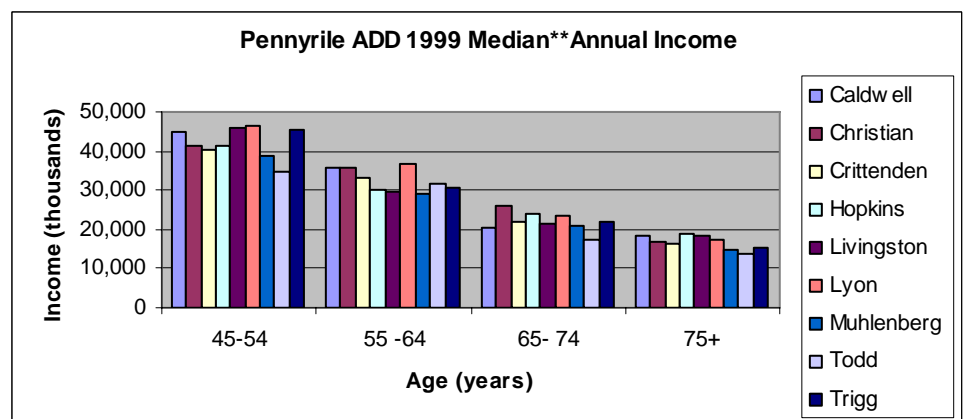

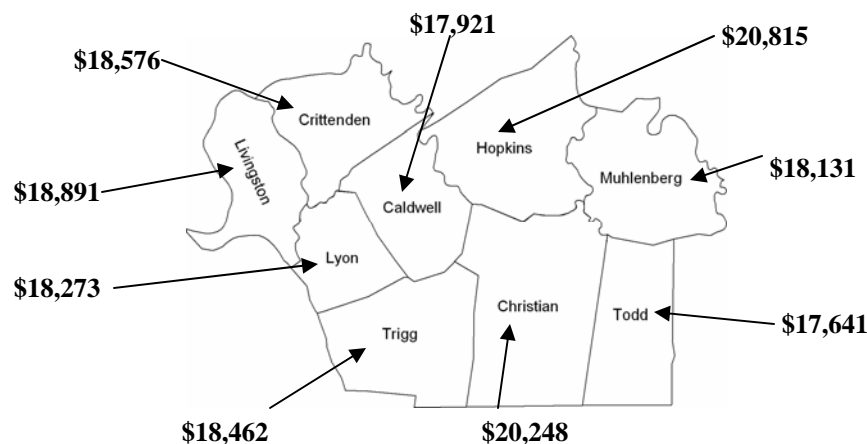

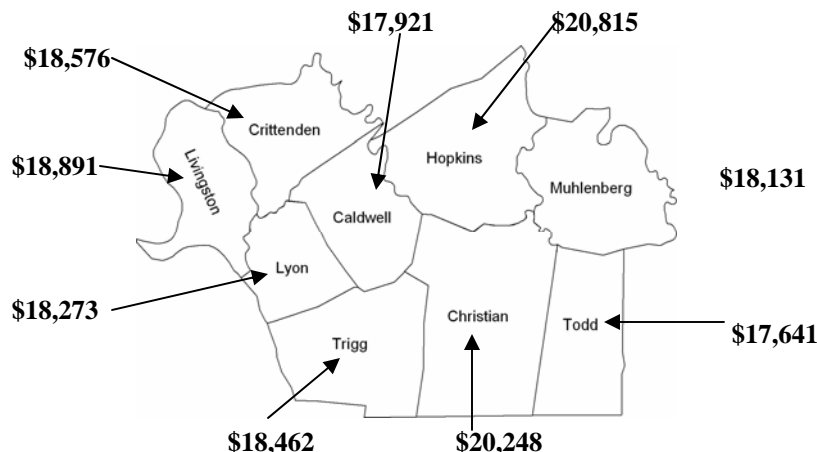
