- In 1999, 26,714 Purchase residents received income from social security compared to 25,529 in 1990. This represented a 4.6% increase.

- In 1999, 6% of Purchase residents received supplemental social security income.

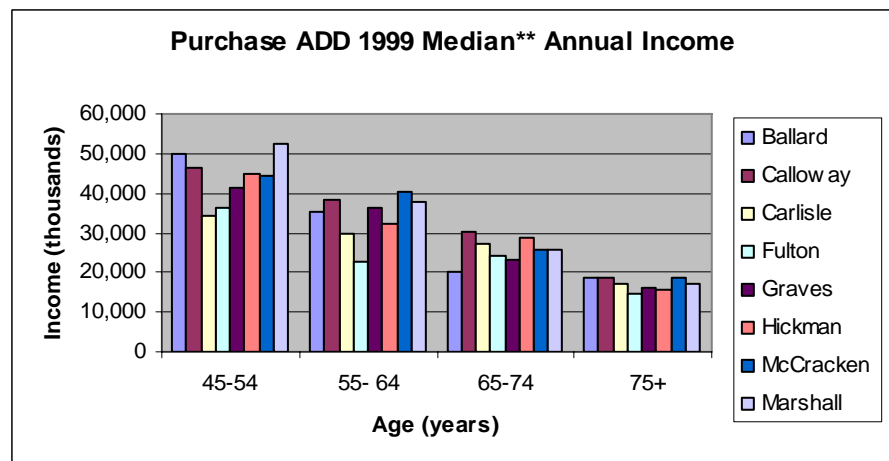
- 33.4% of adults (age 45+) who reside in Purchase have an income of less than \$20,000 a year.

- 29.5% of adults (age 45+) who reside in Purchase have an income greater than \$50,000 a year.

\*\*According to the US Census Bureau: Median income is the income of any individual over the age of 15 and based on the distribution of the total number of persons (US Census Bureau, 2000).

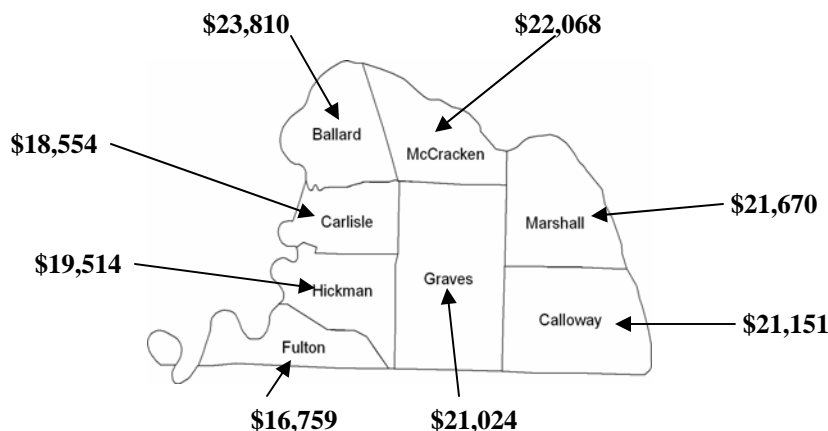
\*\*\*According to the US Census Bureau: Mean income is determined by dividing the aggregate income of a certain population by the number of units in that population (US Census Bureau).

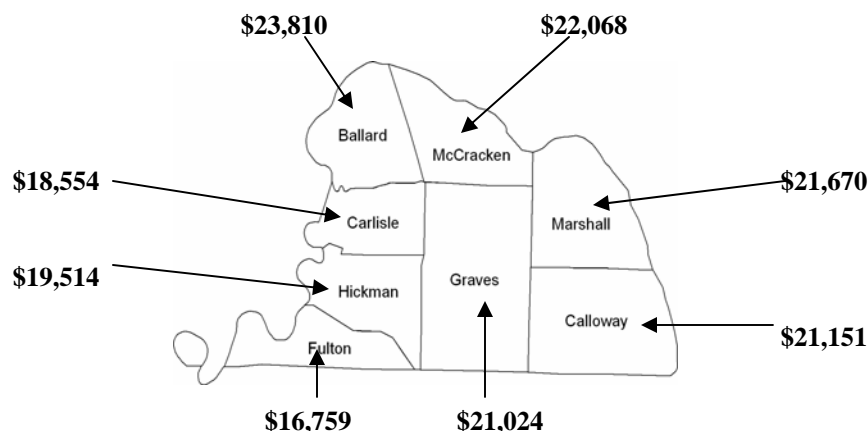
