

Logon to UK Hospital Mainframe Systems to access Patient Management or Patient Care

These instructions are for staff that work at UK Hospital and need to logon the UK Hospital Mainframe systems.

From a computer workstation desktop, double click on the **UK Hosp** icon. The icon picture may vary.



OR if there is no UK Hosp icon on the desktop, click the **Start** button; select **All Programs**, select **Hummingbird Connectivity**, and click **UK Hosp**.

The **UK Hosp** icon will open to the **VTAM Application Menu** screen as shown below:

1. At the **VTAM Application Menu** screen, type **PROD** and press the **Enter** key.
2. Press the **Pause/Break** key to clear the screen.
3. At the blank screen, type **CESN** and press the **Enter** key.
The Welcome to CICS/ESA screen will appear as shown below;

Type your userid and password, then press ENTER:

4. In the **Userid** field, type your **userid** and press the **Tab** key.
5. In the **Password** field, type your **password** and press the **Enter** key.
6. When the “**Sign-on is Complete**” message appears, type **MPAC** and press the **Enter** key.
7. A menu may appear. Select Patient Management or Patient Care by typing an “**X**” in front of the option and press the **Enter** key.
8. The Master screen appears.

Note: If the message “**Invalid Sign-on Attempt**” appears, press the **Pause/Break** key and resume with step **3** above.

Remember: The userid and password are **not case sensitive**. If you have userid or password issues, contact the MCIS Support Center at 323-8586.
