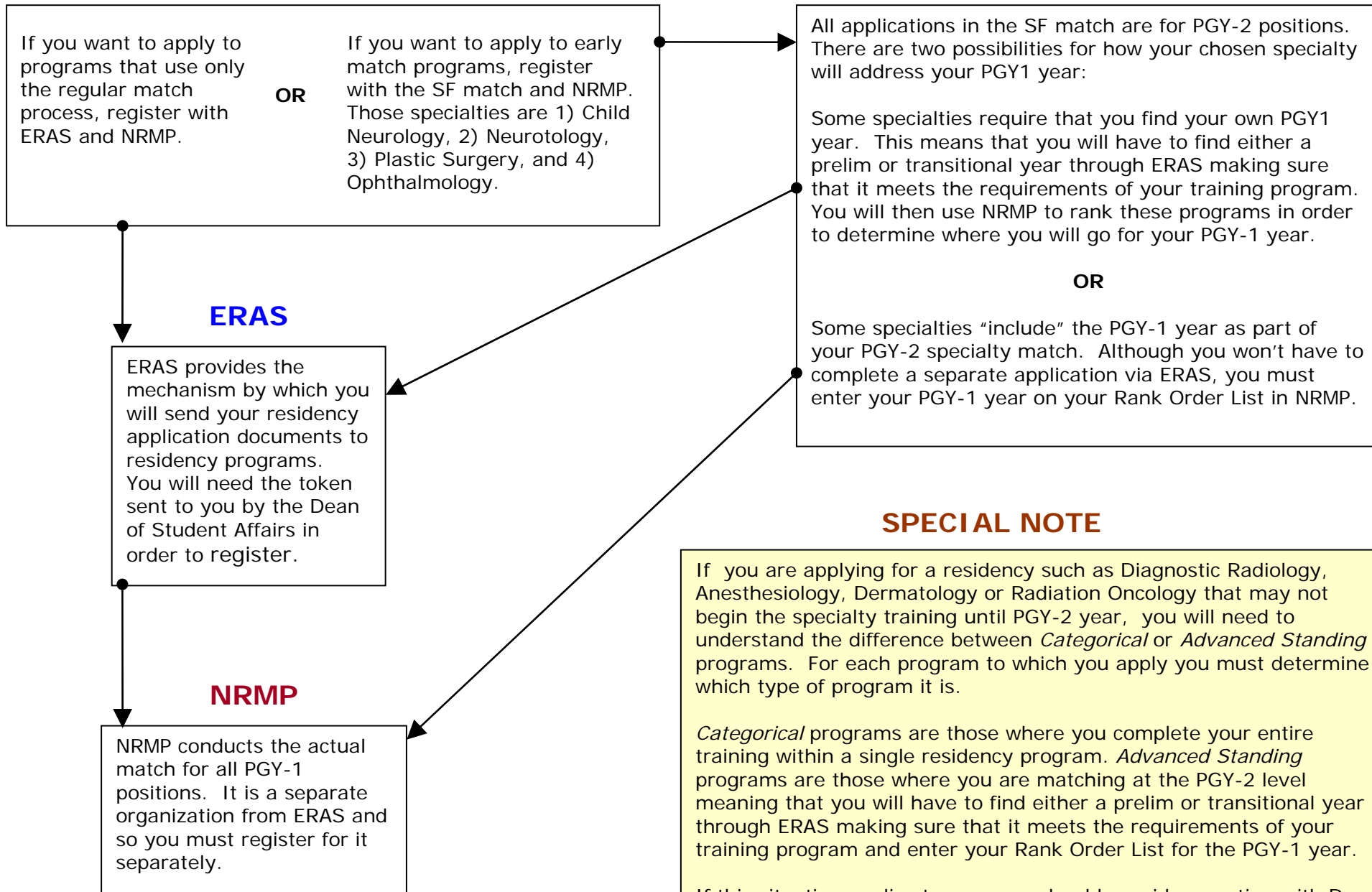


Residency Application & Match At A Glance

SPECIAL NOTE

If you are applying for a residency such as Diagnostic Radiology, Anesthesiology, Dermatology or Radiation Oncology that may not begin the specialty training until PGY-2 year, you will need to understand the difference between *Categorical* or *Advanced Standing* programs. For each program to which you apply you must determine which type of program it is.

Categorical programs are those where you complete your entire training within a single residency program. *Advanced Standing* programs are those where you are matching at the PGY-2 level meaning that you will have to find either a prelim or transitional year through ERAS making sure that it meets the requirements of your training program and enter your Rank Order List for the PGY-1 year.

If this situation applies to you, you should consider meeting with Dr. Cheever in early February prior to entering your rank order list to ensure that you enter your primary and secondary rank order lists correctly.
