

FACULTY POSITION  
ASSOCIATE MEDICAL DIRECTOR  
TRANSFUSION MEDICINE / BLOOD BANK / DONOR APHERESIS

The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at the University of Kentucky Medical Center (UKMC), Lexington, invites applications for a full-time faculty position in Blood Bank / Transfusion Medicine. Appointment rank will be commensurate with experience and may be in either tenure bearing or non-tenure bearing title series. The position is available as of July 1, 2010.

This position offers a complete transfusion medicine experience including the transfusion support of solid organ and bone marrow transplant, a Level I trauma center, NICU and high risk obstetrics, and the spectrum of clinical events faced by a busy 450 bed university hospital and an adjacent 140 bed community hospital. In addition, the three transfusion medicine physicians oversee the therapeutic apheresis service and the FACT-accredited apheresis stem cell collection facility for the bone marrow transplant program. We also provide medical support to the VA Medical Center Blood Bank and Tissue Bank, the University Hospital Tissue Bank, and the Kentucky Blood Center which supplies blood products (83,000 RBC and 10,000 apheresis platelets) to Central and Eastern Kentucky. We have continuous teaching responsibilities for residents in pathology, anesthesiology, and hematology/oncology, for second year medical students, and for the medical technology program. Candidates should have board qualification or eligibility in clinical pathology (or have a primary certificate in a medical specialty) and will have completed fellowship training in blood bank/transfusion medicine. Applications from fellows are encouraged. Candidates who can demonstrate a proven ability to conduct an on-going research program in a clinical, translational or basic area of research will receive preference. The candidate must have the ability to obtain a Kentucky Medical License and staff privileges at our hospitals.

Upon offer of employment, successful applicants must pass a pre-employment drug screen and undergo a national background check as required by University of Kentucky Human Resources.
