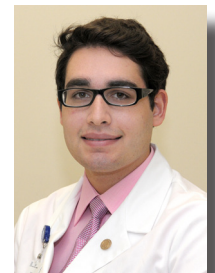

UK HealthCare's New Emergency Department Opened July 14th

The UK Albert B. Chandler Emergency Department opened July 14, 2010 at 5 A.M.. Highlights of the new facility include a Welcome Center with entries and registration areas that are separate for adults and children. The Triage area includes two dedicated adult and child treatment rooms and four treatment rooms that “swing” for adult or pediatric patients.

The Express Care area was designed to provide accelerated care for low-acuity patients with an anticipated treatment time of less than 60 minutes. This area has five exam rooms and a “chair-centric” room featuring six private lounge chairs.

The Adult Critical Care area consists of four crisis rooms and four treatment rooms, three major trauma bays can provide state-of-the-art treatment for up to eight high-acuity patients.

The Makenna David Pediatric Emergency Center has two high-acuity rooms plus 10 standard rooms. Like the Adult Critical Care area the Pediatric Center has direct access to the Radiology area to ensure efficient diagnostic evaluation. The area has a separated waiting area and is designed in a child-friendly color scheme. Waiting pediatric patients are afforded a computer play station area, interactive wall and play table.

The Radiology area has two digital X-ray rooms, two CT scanners, Reading Room, Ultrasound/Panorex room. Ultrasounds may now be performed in the Emergency Department. View more pictures of the New Emergency Department - [Click Here](#).
