

# Asthma Research Study Needs Volunteers

Researchers in the Division of Allergy and Immunology at the University of Kentucky are conducting a research study to monitor breathing and airway inflammation in women that are either users of combination (estrogen and progesterone) oral contraceptive pills or females that do not use hormonal contraception (oral or injection).

**You may qualify for this study if you:**

- **are a female between 18-45 years of age;**
- **have mild to moderate asthma that is under good control at the time of the first study visit; and**
- **are either a user of combination (estrogen + progesterone) oral contraceptive pills or a female that does not use hormonal contraception (oral or injection).**

Participants will receive a medical exam at no cost, intensive monitoring of their asthma, and compensation for their participation. Participation in this study includes six visits over a two month period.
