

Do You Use Tobacco? Have You Been Diagnosed With Head and Neck Cancer?

Researchers with the University of Kentucky College of Medicine, Department of Behavioral Science are conducting a longitudinal study, involving telephone interviews or mail-back questionnaires, exploring tobacco use following head and neck cancer diagnosis.
