



Communication Performance Study Needs Volunteers

- have normal or corrected to normal vision;
- have normal or corrected to normal hearing; and
- have no history of neurological disease.

The study involves two visits to the UK Communication Disorders Clinic located in the Charles T. Wethington, Jr. Building. Each visit will last about one hour. Subjects will be compensated for participation.
