



Infant Feeding Study Needs Volunteers

Researchers at the University of Kentucky, College of Health Sciences and UK Children's Hospital are conducting a research study to investigate the infant tongue during sucking and swallowing. Infants will suck on a special pacifier, take their feeding through a special bottle and have their tongue imaged using an ultrasound; non invasive procedures.

Your infant may be able to participate if they:

- are healthy full term infants born at 37-40 weeks and are appropriate weight for age;
- currently newborn or less than two weeks old;
- are healthy late preterm infants born at 34-36 weeks and appropriate weight for age currently and taking nutrition orally;
- have normal or corrected to normal hearing; and

The study is performed in one visit and will take place by the infants' crib. The visit will last one hour. Participants will be compensated.
